- Prepping beer orders for sales distribution and delivering beer to our pubs
- Troubleshooting and maintenance of equipment
- Maintaining accurate records for all activities
- Safely handle chemicals
- Attending outside sampling events and giving brewery tours as needed
- Maintaining regular and consistent attendance and punctuality
- Acting with integrity and honesty

- Production brewery experience of 1+ years. Ideal candidate will have experience in all areas of the brewery.
- Follows directions well and pays attention to details.
- Desire for mechanical aptitude with ability to maintain and repair equipment.
- Physically able to work on your feet for long hours and be able to safely lift and/or maneuver at 165 lbs.
- Must be able to lift, load, unload, and move products, which requires twisting, turning, bending, and/or squatting repeatedly throughout the day
